	Zacharias' and Mary's reactions to Gabriel's announcements were similar and yet very	
	different. Zacharias said, "Whereby shall I know this?" and Mary said, "How shall this	
	be?" Zacharias was rebuked for unbelief but Mary was not. What's the difference?	
	Though their words sound alike, their hearts were quite different. Zacharias wanted more	
	evidence, but Mary wished for an explanation. The one couldn't be sure, the other couldn't understand. The difference is demanding more evidence before belief or asking for an explanation of something already .	
10	Elisabeth's greeting to Mary shows the power of the Holy Ghost.
